## GOVERNANCE

Green Leaf Foundation, Gossaigaon continues to be an organization with a small group of general body members. Presently, there are 30+ members (5 are women) in general body including 9 (2 are women) members in the Executive Council (EC). The EC consists of the President, Secretary and seven other members. These members come from diverse backgrounds and include a social worker, activist, academic, media person and writer. The Executive Council meets twice a year and General body meets once a year to share programs, the annual report, audited accounts, new policies, and plan new programs. Elections of EC members are held every three years. Upon withdrawal of any member from membership of the general body, new name/s is suggested by the board members, who are then sent an invitation to join the general body.

## STAFF

There are 2 staff members (including 1 woman) in working on different programs. These staff members having experience in social work and composition of staff are followed by caste and religious.

## PLANNING AND MONITORING

Green Leaf Foundation, Gossaigaon conducts monthly staff meetings to review activities and budget. The organization also conducts quarterly meetings to review program budget and planning for next quarter. Senior staff visits the field area frequently for program monitoring. Representatives from donor agencies make visits twice in a year.

## ACHIEVEMENTS

Since its inception, Green Leaf Foundation has made significant strides. It has organized large-scale tree plantation drives, hosted educational awareness programs for underprivileged children, and conducted free health camps for rural populations. The foundation has also launched training initiatives for women, empowering them economically, and supporting farmers with resources and training to adopt sustainable agricultural practices. The foundation has organized various sports programs and competitions for the empowerment of the youths.

## ACTIVITIES

### **Chronological Activities and Achievements of Green Leaf Foundation, Gossaigaon**

#### **1. Inauguration of TET Coaching Center at Haraputa by Green Leaf Foundation (March 14, 2023)**

To improve the success rate of candidates from Gossaigaon Subdivision in Kokrajhar District for the Assam and Sixth Schedule TET examinations announced by the state government in 2023, the Green Leaf Foundation, a well-known voluntary organization, inaugurated a free coaching center named Green Leaf TET Coaching Center. The inauguration took place on March 14, 2023, at 4 PM at Haraputa Girls M.E. School. The event was presided over by Uttam Kumar Ghosh, Assistant Head Teacher of Srirampur High School. Prominent attendees included: Alfred Murmu, Retired Head Teacher of



Haraputa Girls M.E. School, Mostafizur Rahman, Science Teacher of Netaji High English School, Ruhul Amin Sheikh, English Teacher; Abu Hanif Jowaddar, Principal of Simultapu Sankar Azan Jatiya Bidyalaya, Mokhlesur Rahman, Principal Sankar Azan Jatiya Bidyalaya, Padmabil, Mafizur Rahman, Advocate at Gossaigaon Sub-divisional Judicial Court. The coaching program, held at Vidya Bikash College, was conducted over 42 days, with classes four days a week by 12 highly experienced teachers. The initiative successfully concluded on April 28, 2023.

## 2. Submission of Memorandum to Northeast Frontier Railway (May 29, 2023)

On May 29, 2023, the Green Leaf Foundation submitted a memorandum to the General Manager of Northeast Frontier Railway through the Station Superintendent, demanding the stoppage of the following trains at Gossaigaon Hat Railway Station: Shifung Express, Saraighat Express, Capital Express, North East Express, and Vande Bharat Express. The program was supported by Arunanav Dev Sharma, a member of the Assam Rail Passengers' Association, along with Dr. Tarani Kanta Kalita, Chief Advisor of Green Leaf Foundation, Mizanur Rahman, President of Green Leaf Foundation, and other members of the organization.

## 3. World Environment Day Celebrated in Gossaigaon by Green Leaf Foundation

Green Leaf Foundation, a leading voluntary organization of Gossaigaon Subdivision, organized a tree plantation drive at various locations to mark World Environment Day on 05/03/2023.

As part of the initiative, the foundation planted over 200 saplings of rare and endangered fruit-bearing trees, such as wax apple (Jamrul), black plum (Jamun), custard apple (Noni), sweet mango (Madhuri Aam), elephant apple (Kordoi), Burmese grape (Leteku), wood apple (Bael), Indian olive (Jolphai), gooseberry (Amlakhi), and others. These plantations were carried out in about 15 different locations across the subdivision, especially in border areas where such tree species are disappearing.

The tree plantation program was conducted under the leadership of Mizanur Rahman, President of Green Leaf Foundation, with the support of advisors and over fifty members. Trees were planted in several schools, religious institutions, clubs, and government offices, including: Harafuta Sporting Club, Howriapet Mosques & Madrasas, Damarapara M.E. School, Charpara L.P. School, Bhomrabil High School, Mahatma Gandhi Model Academy, Bhomrabil Azad Vidyapith etc. The initiative aimed to promote environmental awareness and restore the region's biodiversity.

#### 4. Assam Constituency Delimitation and Green Leaf Foundation (June 20, 2023 – August 11, 2023)

On February 28, 2020, the Election Commission of India issued a notification regarding the delimitation of parliamentary and legislative assembly constituencies in Assam. Following various procedures, the Election Commission published the draft proposal for delimitation on June 20, 2023, through its gazette notification. Stakeholders were invited to submit suggestions or objections regarding the draft proposal to the Election Commission's office by July 11, 2023.

Based on this notification, the Green Leaf Foundation, Gossaigaon, submitted a memorandum to the Election Commission addressing issues related to boundary demarcation, village inclusion, exclusion, and other concerns in Kokrajhar District. On July 19, 2023, the Election Commission conducted a hearing at Srimanta Sankaradeva International Auditorium in Guwahati based on the submitted memoranda. Representing the Green Leaf Foundation, President Mizanur Rahman, Legal Advisor Mafizur Rahman, and Advisor Kazi Bulbul Ahmed participated in the hearing. The Foundation was led in this effort by Abdur Rahim Sheikh, a retired Assam Administrative Service officer and former Deputy Commissioner of South Salmara-Mankachar District.

In the final delimitation list for Assam, published on August 11, 2023, the Election Commission addressed most of the demands raised in the memorandum submitted by the Green Leaf Foundation. These included: 1) Exclusion of Anthai Bari VCDC and Guwabari VCDC from Dotma (ST) Assembly Constituency., 2) Exclusion of No. 2 Bhomrabil (VCDC) and No. 2 Serfanguri (VCDC) from Baukhungri Assembly Constituency and their inclusion in Gossaigaon Assembly Constituency., 3) Exclusion of Haraputa VCDC, Bhairiguri VCDC, and Srirampur VCDC from Baukhungri Assembly Constituency and their inclusion in Gossaigaon Assembly Constituency., 4) Exclusion of Majerdabri VCDC from Baukhungri Assembly Constituency and its inclusion in Gossaigaon Assembly Constituency., 5) Transfer of villages from Kachugaon Development Block, such as Nandipur, Hathigarh, Jaleswari, and Nabin Nagar, from Gossaigaon Assembly Constituency to Dotma (ST) Assembly Constituency., 6) Inclusion of Babubil VCDC in Gossaigaon Assembly Constituency., 7) Exclusion of Tipkai and Monglajhora VCDCs from Gossaigaon Assembly Constituency and their inclusion in Parbatjhora Assembly Constituency. These revisions were incorporated into the final delimitation list. In this context, the Green Leaf Foundation extends its gratitude to the Election Commission of India, Kokrajhar District Administration, Gossaigaon Subdivision Administration, retired Assam Administrative Service officer Abdur Rahim Sheikh, Legal Advisors - Mokhlesur Rahman and Mafizur Rahman, Advisor Kazi Bulbul Ahmed, and the Action Committee for Review of Delimitation (ACRD) for their support and cooperation.

#### 5. Annual Inter Institute Competition Programme by Green Leaf Foundation (Septemner 09, 2023)

In alignment with the integration of general education into the Islamic education system, fostering a competitive spirit among the students of madrasas, and promoting harmony between Islamic and general education, the second edition of the inter-madrasa competition for the Gossaigaon subdivision was organized on 07/09/2023 at the Bhomarabil Hafizia Madrasa premises, under the initiative of the Green Leaf Foundation.

Under the leadership of Mizanur Rahman, President of the Green Leaf Foundation, ten Hafizia Madrasas and Banat (women's) Madrasas from Gossaigaon subdivision and its surrounding areas participated. These included Rowjatul Uloom Hafizia Madrasa, Sapkata, Bhomarabil Hafizia Madrasa, Darul Uloom Serfanguri Madrasa, Noore Najim Jamiatul Banat, Garam Bazar, Borjan Hafizia Madrasa (Kharkhori), Madrasatul Banat, Serfanguri, Ashraful Uloom, Bherbheri, Ayesha Siddika (R.A) Madrasatul Banat, Kadamguri, Ayesha Siddika (R.A) Madrasatul Banat, Hatidhura, Rahmatullah Hafizia Madrasa, Babubil, among others. Competitions were held in Holy Quran recitation, Ghazal singing, impromptu speech, and quizzes on Islamic, historical, and general knowledge.

After the inaugural recitation by Hafiz Qari Somesh Ali Sheikh, the Quran recitation competition saw Aminur Rahman and Nur Mohammad Sheikh from Rawjatul Uloom Hafizia Madrasa, Sapkata, securing the first and second positions, respectively. The third position was claimed by Abul Kalam Azad from Darul Uloom Serfanguri Madrasa. In the Ghazal competition, Khairun Nessa from Noore Najim Jamiatul Banat, Garam Bazar, won the first prize, while Rufsana Khatun from Madrasatul Banat, Serfanguri, and Armina Khatun from Noore Najim Jamiatul Banat, Garam Bazar, secured the second and third positions, respectively. In the impromptu speech competition, Abul Kalam from Bhomarabil Hafizia Madrasa took the first position, Mehenaz Khatun from Noore Najim Jamiatul Banat, Garam Bazar, secured the second position, and Muhsina Khatun from Ayesha Siddiq (R.A.) Madrasatul Banat, Hathidhura, claimed the third position. 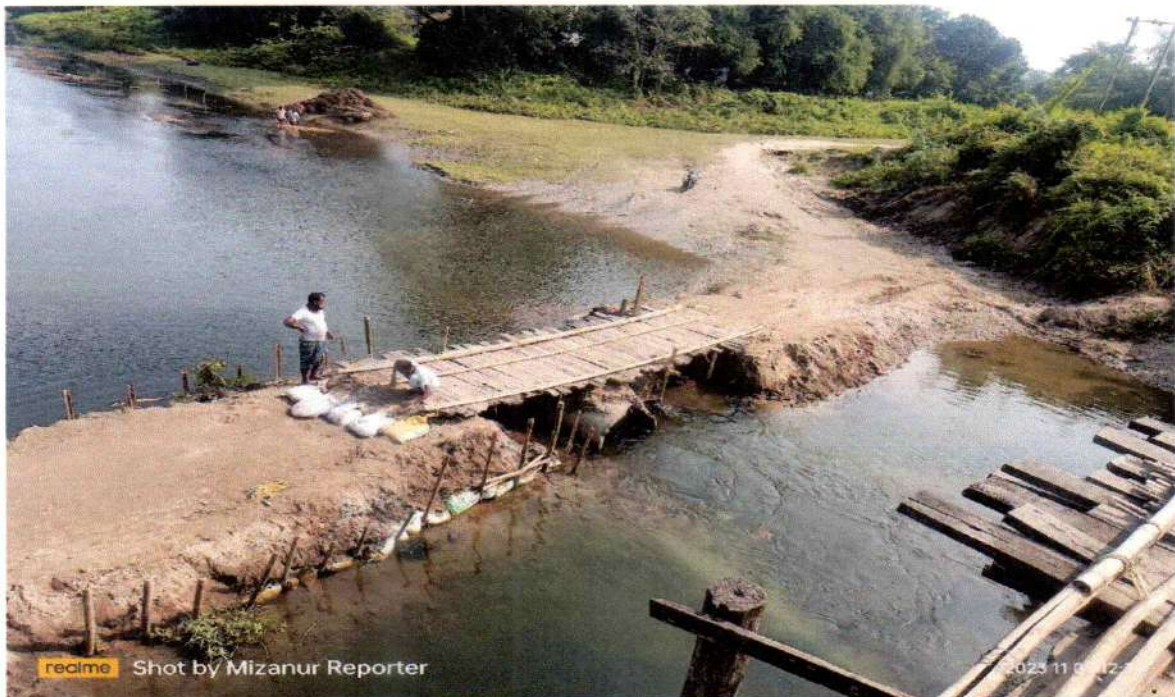

## 7. Bridge Repairing over the Harafuta River (November 23, 2023).

On 23rd November 2023, the bridge over the Harafuta River, adjacent to National Highway 27 at 1 No. Bhomrabil, collapsed. Following this, the Green Leaf Foundation took the initiative to reconstruct the bridge.

Additionally, at various times, the bridge was rebuilt, and a small road was constructed underneath it with the joint efforts of Sajal Foundation, Green Leaf Foundation, and local residents.

To ensure the permanent construction of the bridge, multiple applications and memorandums were submitted to Naba Kumar Sarania, the Member of Parliament from



Kokrajhar Lok Sabha Constituency; Jiran Basumatary, the MLA of Gossaigaon Assembly Constituency; and Pramod Boro, the Chief of BTC.

## 8. Submission of Memorandum for RCC Bridge Construction (December 1, 2023)

Green Leaf Foundation submitted a memorandum to Member of Parliament Shri Naba Kumar Sarania, demanding the construction of an RCC bridge at Bhomrabil and advocating for additional train stoppages at local stations.

## 9. Presentation of Samsul Hoque Memorial and Other Awards (December 18, 2023)

Under the banner of Green Leaf Foundation, a leading NGO of Gossaigaon organized Late. Prof. Samsul Hoque Jeevan Sangram Award ceremony on December 18, 2024 today at Gossaigaon Press Club with a daylong programme in Kokrajhar District. Besides a commemorative meet was also organized where Azhar Ali, retired superintendent of Nabajyati High Madrasa presided over the meeting and award ceremony followed by introduction of guest by Mijanur Rahman, President, Green Leaf Foundation, NGO Gossaigaon. On the occasion, Khanindra Nath Das, Senior Journalist and President of Gossaigaon Shakha Sahitya Sabha, senior journalist Abdul Wahab Ahmed, Dr. Taranai Kanta Kalita, Veterinary Officer cum Secretary, Gossaigaon Shakha Sahitya Sabha, Jahangir Hussain, DPO, SSA, Kokrajhar, Mafida Hasan wife of Late. Prof Samsul Hoque spoke lucidly on the enormous contributions of late Professor Samsul Haque in the field of education, social, political and religious functions etc. The event recalled Late. Prof, Samsul Hoque's punitive role played in restoring peace by risking their lives during the horrific communal clashes between Adivasi-Bodo and Bodo-Muslim riot in 1996-98 and in 2012 in Kokrajhar district. An atmosphere of mourning was witnessed during the speakers speech on Samsul Hoque's recorded contribution while establishing various institutions including connecting a cordial relation with the government and administration, strong leadership of Late.
